Are Dinosaurs a Great Mystery?

There's no denying that dinosaurs really lived. The land dinosaurs were likely

created on the sixth day with the other great land creatures, while the marine dinosaurs were created on the fifth day with the other denizens of the deep. So what happened to them?

One of the most popular theories is that a huge rock from space, perhaps miles across, struck the Earth.
