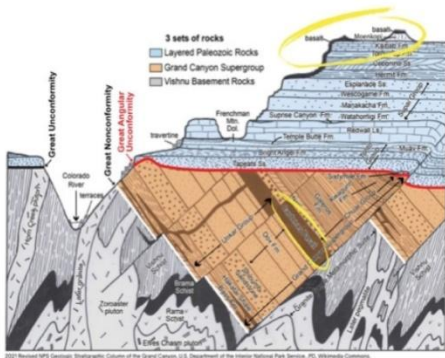

A Case of Bad Dates



"... and the Scripture cannot be broken..." - John 10:35b

Scientists who believe in creation have always said evolutionary methods for dating the ages of rocks give ages that are too old. There are many examples of how those who believe in evolutionary long ages exaggerate the abilities of their dating methods.

For instance, the dating methods that give the most ancient ages for rocks work on rock that was once lava. In the Grand Canyon of the western United States, we find two rock formations that were once lava. One is intruded deep in the canyon. It is dated by evolutionists as over a billion years old.

There is a second lava flow, universally recognized as the youngest rocks, that flowed from the top of the rim of the canyon all the way to the river at the bottom of the canyon. This flow is dated as merely thousands of years. However, scientists from the Institute for Creation Research had samples from this flow dated at three laboratories using the same method used to date the older flow. While the rock should have been too young to produce a date, it was actually dated as being older than the rock at the bottom of the canyon!

Huge evolutionary ages are not well supported by science. There are no good scientific challenges to the truth of the Bible.
